Warm Springs Counseling Center Introduces Multidisciplinary ASD Clinic in Meridian

Today, Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) affect approximately 1 in 91 children. Warm Springs Counseling Center (WSSC) has established an Autism Diagnostic Clinic to meet the growing community need by providing early diagnosis and intervention for children with ASD.

What types of disorders will be assessed?

- Autistic Disorder
- Asperger's Disorder
- Pervasive Developmental Disorder - Not Otherwise Specified (PDD NOS)

Autism Diagnostic Clinic provides:

- Early screening
- Developmentally appropriate assessment
- Comprehensive evaluation
- Multidisciplinary team approach to diagnosis
- Early intervention
- Collaboration with other professionals

Assessments investigate:

- Physical/neurological wellbeing
- Cognitive development
- Social skills
- Play skills
- Communication skills
- Motor abilities and sensory concerns
- Emotional/behavioral adjustment

Children and adolescents, ages 18 months to 18 years
